

Intellectual Property Law IG Award for Best Published Work

The Intellectual Property Law Interest Group of the American Society of International Law is pleased to announce the establishment of an annual IPLIG Award for the Best Published Work in the Field of International Intellectual Property Law for 2024. Submissions should be made by e-mail attachment of the published work to <u>lawofficeofmamcgrail@gmail.com</u>, with name of author, address (e-mail and regular mail), affiliation, and affirmation of membership in ASIL. Electronic submissions should be made in portable document format (.pdf).

A published work may include works (such as law review articles) accepted for publication but not yet published, or works published in 2024. Both solo-authored and jointly-authored papers are eligible. Law students as well as practitioners and academics at all levels who are members of ASIL are encouraged to apply.

The work will be evaluated by a Selection Committee that will consist of IPLIG co-chairs and experts in intellectual property law. In assessing the submitted works, the Selection Committee will take into consideration the following criteria: a) coherence and structure of the argument; b) quality of analysis; c) depth of research and appropriateness of references to the relevant literature; d) originality of the topic and relevance of the contribution to the field of international intellectual property law

The Award carries with it a monetary prize of \$100 and one year's complimentary membership to ASIL. The recipient will be acknowledged at the annual ASIL meeting in Washington, D.C.
